Introduction

Overview

Dentists and dental care professionals (DCPs) must be registered with the General Dental Council (GDC) to practise in the UK. Everyone who joins our registers must be suitably qualified or pass an assessment, and meet the health, character and English language requirements to be considered fit to practise as a member of the dental team.

Applications can be made in several ways, by demonstrating one of the following:

- A recognised UK qualification.
- A relevant European diploma.
- A recognised overseas qualification.
- An assessment of suitability to register, via a GDC panel assessment of skills and knowledge.
- A pass in Parts 1 and 2 of the Overseas Registration Examination.

Specialist lists

We also maintain lists of dentists who are suitably qualified or experienced to be considered specialists in specific areas of dentistry.

Continuing Professional Development (CPD)

Undertaking CPD is a compulsory part of registration with the GDC. Dental professionals must meet our CPD requirements to maintain their registration.

We also require evidence of up to date CPD from anyone wishing to re-join the register.


The total number of dentists and DCPs on the register as of 31 December 2021

This table shows the total number of individuals on the dentist and DCP registers. There was a 0.7% increase in the total number of dental professionals from 113,960 at the end of 2020 to 114,777 at the end of 2021.¹







Dentists on the register by region of qualification 2018 – 2021







Due to the pandemic, the ORE Part 2 was not held between February 2020 and December 2021. This has resulted in a reduction in registration via the ORE route. Those registered in 2021 via the ORE route would have passed their exam at an earlier exam sitting.


New additions to DCP register by country of qualifications 2019 – 2021



The significant increase in 'rest of world qualified' registrants in 2020 and 2021 is due to the increase in overseas qualified dentists applying for registration as a hygienist and/or a therapist. This followed an increase in awareness of this route to DCP registration for overseas qualified dentists, at a time when the ORE was suspended due to COVID restrictions.



Although there was a 20% increase in the overall number of dentist removals, from 1,198 in 2020 to 1,434 in 2021, this was still a lower number compared to both 2018 and 2019.

80 of the 1,434 removals went on to the restore in the same year.

Dentist removals from the register in 2021 by removal reason





There was a 9% increase in the overall number of DCP removals, from 4,803 in 2020 to 5,255 in 2021.

Of the 5,255 removals 390 went onto restore in the same year.

Note on specialist lists: there was a increase of 3% in the number of speciality titles at the end of 2021, from 4,253 titles in 2020 to 4,378 titles in 2021. Percentages may not add up to 100%, as they are rounded to the nearest whole number.

Register profile – equality and diversity

The charts below show our registrant profile analysed with reference to the Equality Act protected characteristics³. All dental professionals are given the option to provide and update this information voluntarily.

Several of the characteristics do not have full responses on the charts, categorised as 'unknown'. Providing this data is not mandatory, although we encourage people to provide this information to help us improve our services and processes and ensure that any potential discrimination or inequities can be identified and removed.

We will publish additional data sets with regards to equality and diversity in future publications as we build further data in this area.

Our EDI Strategy for 2021-23 sets out our objectives to ensure that we are an active champion of diversity, equality and inclusion inside our organisation and the sector we regulate.

Registrants with disabilities as of 31 December 2021

Less than 1% of dentists or DCPs identified as having a disability. The numbers here are exceptionally small, which may be due to the understanding of what is meant by the term 'disability.' Under the Equality Act 2010, a disability is described as a physical or mental impairment that has substantial and long-term negative effect on the ability to carry out normal activities. This could include long-term health conditions, depression, and anxiety, and neurodivergent conditions.










Dentist ethnic groupings as at 31 December 2021



DCP - ethnic groupings as at 31 December 2021




Registrant grouping by religion as of 31 December 2021

Dentist - grouping by religion as at 31 December 2021




DCP - grouping by religion as at 31 December 2021




Registrant marital status as of 31 December 2021

Dentist - marital status groupings as at 31 December 2021




DCPs - marital status groupings as at 31 December 2021




Registrant sexual orientation as of 31 December 2021
