	Progress: RCS Edin have provided an up-to-date risk register which has review dates specified throughout.
	Action 2: Provide evidence of how EE report concerns have been addressed.
	Progress: RCS Edin provided evidence of Examination Assessor reports as well as a response to the report document, which provides assurance that any actions are taken from the EE reports and that changes are presented and are considered by the Specialty Advisory Board.

E4	Action 4: Provide evidence of actions taken to ensure consistency across all exams.				
	Progress: RCS Edin has conducted a training session for Assessors in May 2023 with an additional date planned. RCS Edin plan to have 20 Assessors trained within the next 3-4 months.				
	A guidance document for Assessors was provided which provided assurance that there is a consistent approach to completing the Examination Assessors report which also ensures consistency across all exams.

E7	Action 5: Provide evidence that job descriptions for lead examiners and assessors have been developed and are in use.				
	Progress: RCS Edin provided evidence of job descriptions and Assessor and Examiner code of conduct documents, which were approved through Dental Exams Committee. The Job descriptions are published on the RCS Edin website and form part of the training.
